EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 08-37

(Expanding Membership of Governor's Council on Physical Fitness)

WHEREAS, the Governor's Council on Physical Fitness (the "Council") was established by Executive Order 07-52 to promote health and wellness in the state through development of a plan of action to increase physical fitness through regular exercise and sound nutrition practices among Floridians of all ages and to reduce the rate of obesity and resulting chronic diseases; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order 07-52, as amended by Executive Order 07-195, limited the Council to 15-21 members, representing a broad spectrum of interested parties, including educators, health care practitioners, senior citizen and special needs advocates, physical fitness and sports organizations, parks and recreation experts, business community and corporate interests, representatives of government, and private citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Council may better achieve its mission by expanding its membership beyond the limitation imposed by Executive Orders 07-52 and 07-195;

NOW THEREFORE, I, CHARLIE CRIST, as Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Florida Constitution, and all other applicable laws, issue the following Executive Order, to take effect immediately:

Section 1.

The Governor's Council on Physical Fitness shall consist of 15-25 members appointed by the Governor.
